

AURELIUS supports South-Africa based NGO Vulamasango by donating for a new and safe Toyota-Minibus to take kids to schools

[Vulamasango – Open Gates](#), a South-Africa (Capetown) based Non-Profit-Organisation, provides a permanent home for children and youth that were orphaned, neglected, abused and are impoverished. To enable the kids reaching their schools safely, the organization must use a suitable minibus for transportation. However, the currently used vehicle was involved in accidents and has travelled more than 350.000 kilometres in the last twelve years – therefore cannot provide the safety needed for the kids.

AURELIUS and its employees are deeply committed to social engagement and the wish to contribute for society. To support the purchase of a new minibus with necessary safety features, a member of the AURELIUS management board waived salary. Furthermore, AURELIUS added to the amount. Vulamasango thus received a donation by AURELIUS amounting to EUR 37.000 for the much-needed new vehicle.

Social engagement is part of AURELIUS Corporate Citizenship and Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) philosophy. For AURELIUS, this means contributing to society at large, beyond the confines of the company.
