

Anti-corruption (UN GC Principle 10, GRI 205)

AURELIUS condemns corruption in any form and will not tolerate it in its business activities or those of its business partners.

The business activities of AURELIUS always comply with the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Convention against Bribery of Foreign Public Officials (1997) and the UN Convention against Corruption (2003). In the fight against bribery and corruption, the relevant laws are followed in all jurisdictions within which the company operates.

Prevention of corruption (GRI 205-2)

Prevention of and fight against corruption is the focus of our compliance work. Anti-corruption training for employees is conducted on a regular basis. Anti-corruption guidelines support employees navigate difficult situations in everyday business.

Corruption prevention also includes prohibiting practices such as lobbying and donations to political parties or elected officials that may lead to conflicts of interest.

Corruption prevention has proven efficient for the company in recent years. In 2021, as in previous years, no cases of corruption were reported (GRI 205-3). Furthermore, no ongoing corruption proceedings were pending in the financial years 2021 and 2020.
